Application Pre-Screening Reminders

Getting Started

1. The applicant must **NOT** have access to other health insurance programs, such as ACA, Medicaid, Medicare, or employer-based insurance
2. If the applicant is a citizen, legal permanent resident, or have TPS (ACA eligible) or work authorization (permit, visa) they are **not** eligible for CHAP
3. DACA is **not** ACA eligible and if they have employer-based insurance, they are also **not** CHAP eligible
4. The applicant does not need an ITIN or have had filed taxes to qualify for CHAP

Application Information

1. Insurance Plan Information: Kaiser Permanente Individuals & Families (KPIF) Off Exchange Plan (Gold Level) with no monthly premium or copays. **Note:** There are charges if the member goes to the ER or is admitted to a hospital (co-insurance). If the community partner is an authorized representative, KP will work with the community party to ensure cost is resolved through the external hospital's financial assistance program
2. Coverage Start Date: January 1 to December 31. Members **must** reapply yearly starting August 1 to October 1 (please look for the reapplication kit, text message reminders, post card reminders etc. in the mail)
3. **Important:** Notify KP if the member relocates by calling Member Services at 1-800-777-7902
4. Income Verification Examples: most recent (one month's) paystubs, taxes or W-2. If the applicant doesn't have one of these, complete the KP income documentation (self-attestation form) and attach with open enrollment forms.
